Process Updates

- xml2rfc has been updated to allow non-ASCII characters in <t>
 - <u> is not required
 - New option --warn-bare-unicode for warning about bare Unicode in tags where it should be closely inspected
- non-ASCII mathematical notation allowed where reasonable (example: [RFC 9340](#))
- ASCII equivalents are used for punctuation

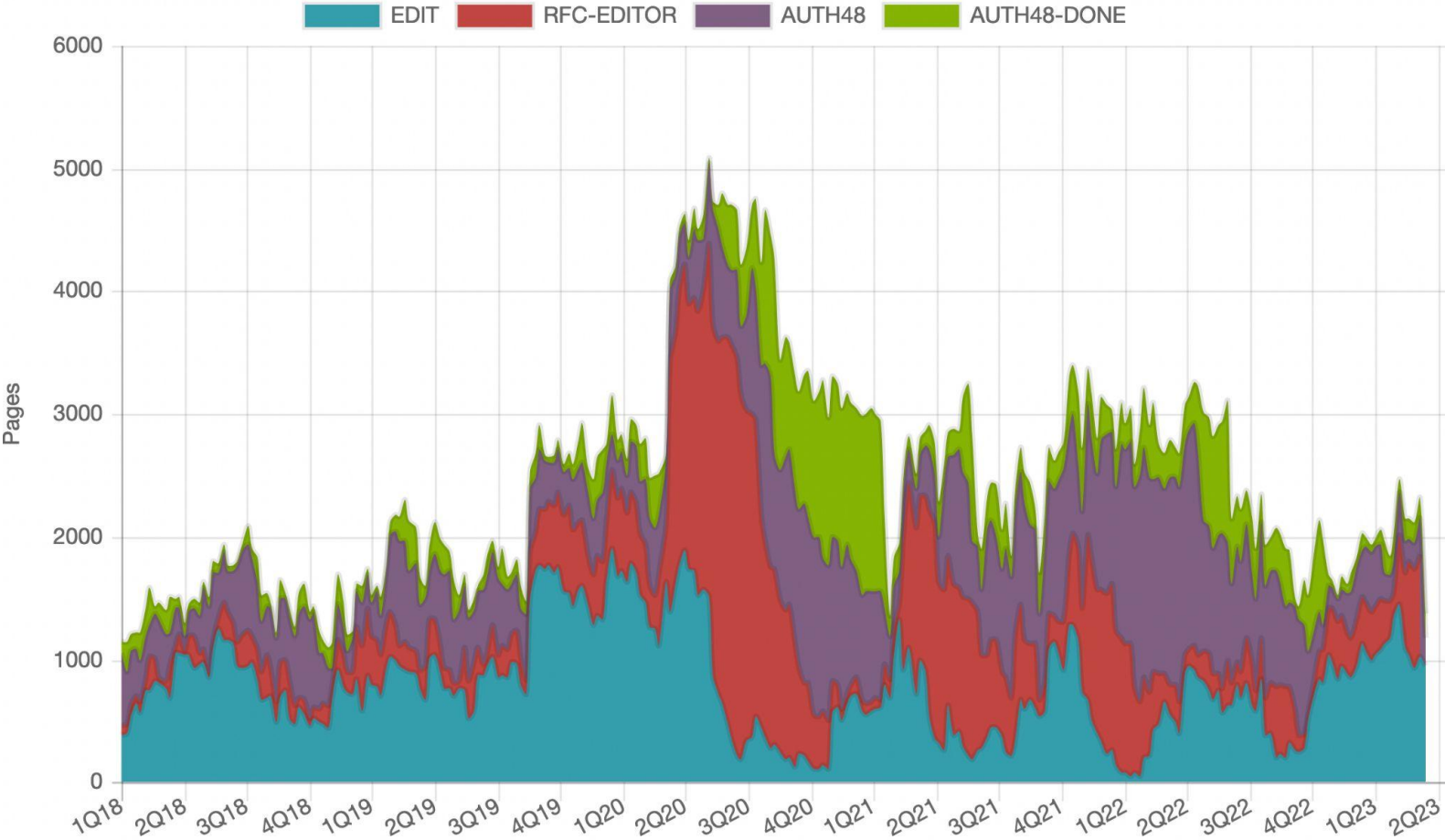

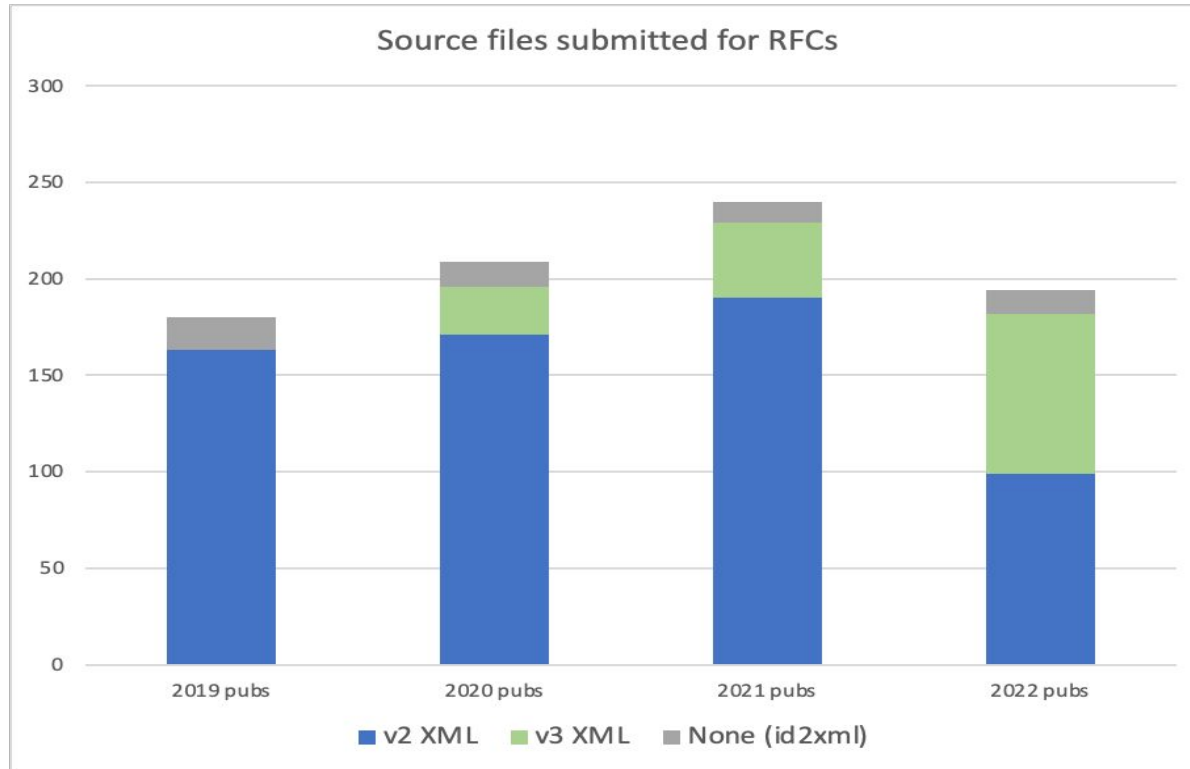

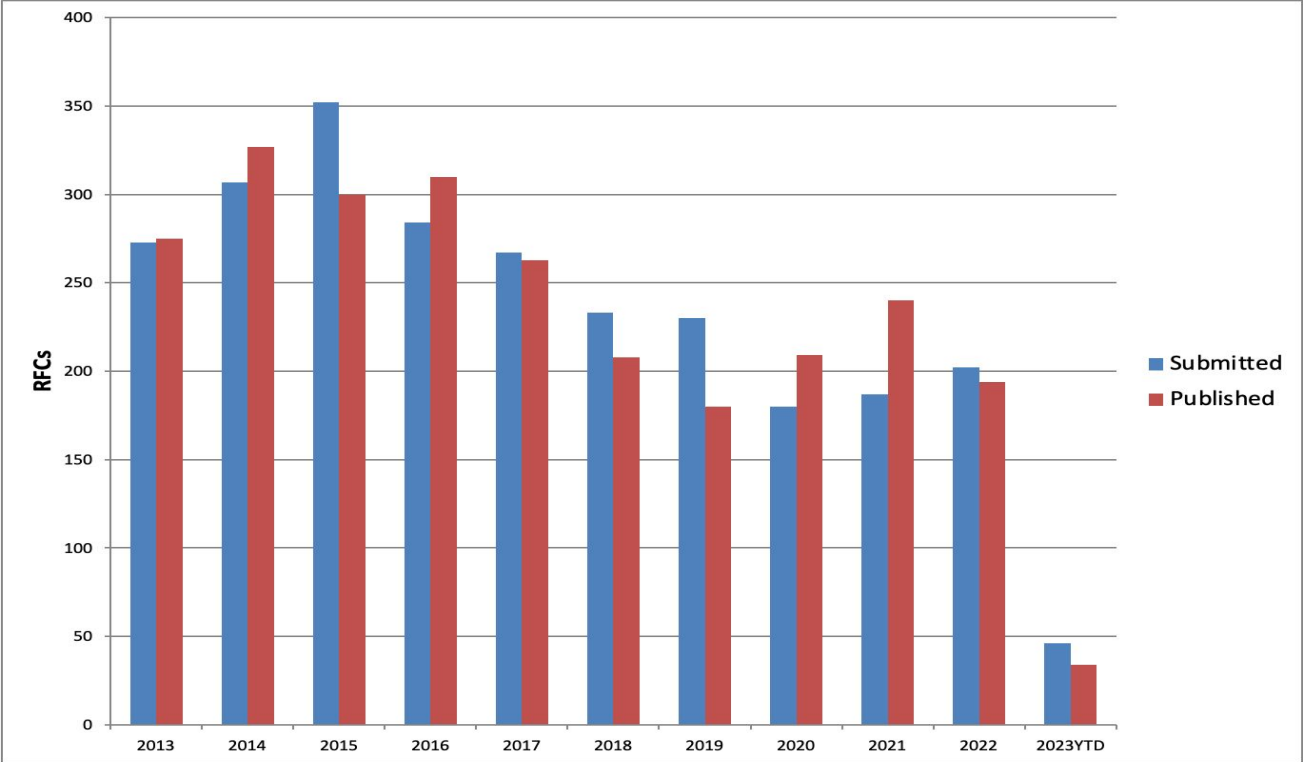
Pages by state from Jan. 1, 2018 to March 31, 2023



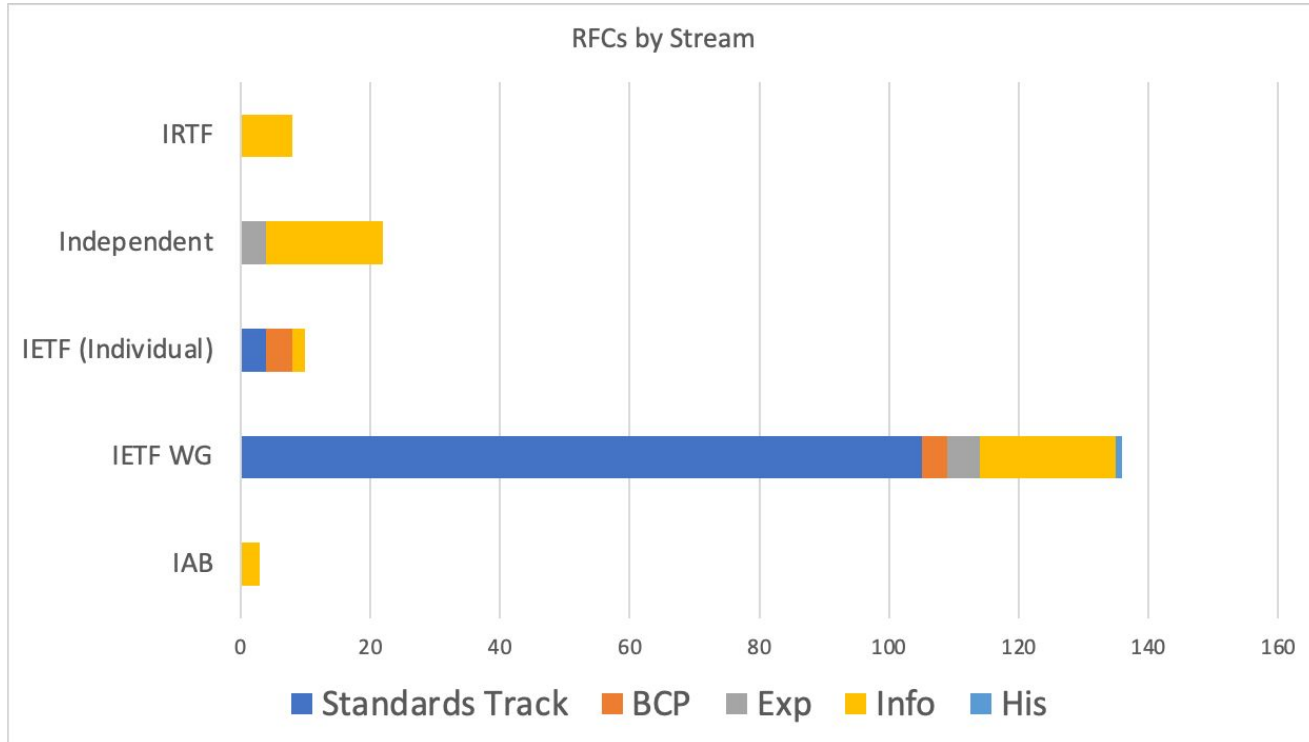

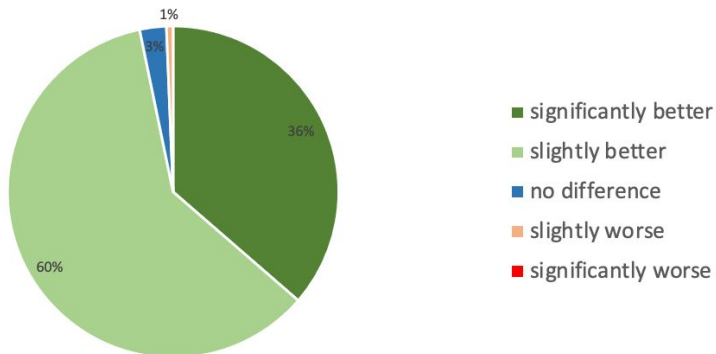
2022 RFCs by Stream and Status



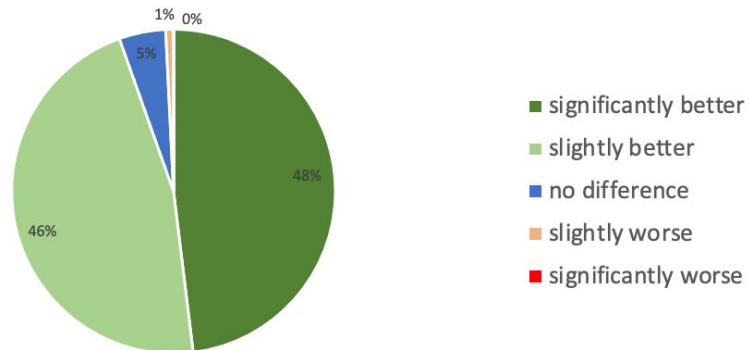
